Announcement Title *	LITIGATION UPDATE
Description	<p>ASTI Holdings Limited ('the Company') wishes to announce that the High Court of Singapore has dismissed a Competitor's application for injunction with cost in the cause.</p> <p>The above relates to an earlier announcement made by the Company on 12 September 2008 wherein we had informed that the Competitor had commenced legal proceedings in Malacca against one of our subsidiary for alleged infringement of certain of their patents, arising from our subsidiary manufacture and sale of certain semiconductor equipment.</p> <p>Thereafter, the Competitor had commenced further legal proceedings against our subsidiary in Singapore on substantially the same allegations of infringement of their patents. Concurrently, the Competitor had also applied to the High Court of Singapore for the grant of an interlocutory injunction to restrain the subsidiary from using, manufacturing and selling the allegedly infringing equipment pending trial.</p> <p>The dismissal of the Competitor's application for interlocutory injunction by the High Court of Singapore is the latest update on this case. The Company will make further announcements as and when further significant developments arise.</p>
